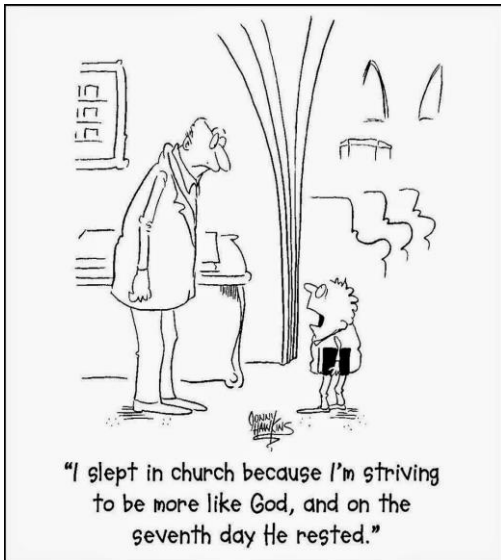
Souper Sunday

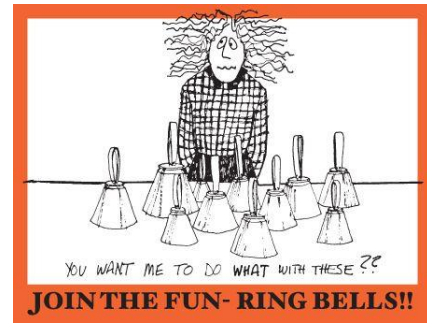
We want to thank the Upland Fire Company for volunteering to bring lights and help with the evening.
