

Devotional Thought...

Scripture: Matthew 11:28-30

This scripture passage says that we need to turn our burdens over to God. Burdens are often something that we think about all the time and can cause us anxiety. Burdens can be anything from finances to family and everything in between. We all have them, and the message Jesus gives us is the same: come to me and I will give you rest.

I struggle with knowing how to ask Jesus for help. It feels easier to make a list of blessings and give thanks for the good things than it does to ask for help with my struggles. Yet, I believe that Jesus calls all of us to go to Him with our struggles as well as our joys. Jesus tells us in this passage that if we go to him, we will learn from him. Turing to Jesus in times of struggle doesn't always come naturally. It is a learned behavior. We have to practice asking Jesus for help and listening for his answer. When we place our trust in Jesus, recognizing that he is always faithful, then we can more easily turn to Him no matter what is happening.

Humans sometimes let us down. They tell us that we have to figure things out on our own. Jesus tells us to come to him and to keep coming, to always bring our burdens to him. He loves us, he is gentle and humble in heart and he wants to help us carry our burdens. When we trust him, we are able to let him help us carry our burdens.
