

Devotional Thought...

In my Widow's group, we choose a word for the year. This year I chose "mindful." I have practiced formal mindfulness for the last couple of years. This year, I wanted to focus on being mindful as I go about my everyday activities, to be more present and not always thinking ahead or about the past. When it came time to choose my Bible verse for the year, I chose Colossians 3:12 because I felt it expressed many of the things I wanted to be more mindful about in carrying out what God wanted me to do.



As I take my walks along the river, I think about being one of God's loved people and how lucky I am to live close to one of his natural beauties instead of counting steps. When I am at Planet Fitness, I'm starting to notice when someone seems to be all alone or there for the first time and needs a smile or quick introduction or invite to join my group of friends.

My brother has been struggling a lot this year, and while I can't fix his medical problems, I have started texting him an inspirational thought for the day to let him know I am always here for him. Sometimes, he even texts me one back. In my Widow's group, there is ample opportunity to be compassionate and really listen as new widows join a meeting or just pay attention to who may be struggling more this month and needs someone to talk to or a ride to the next meeting.

People have asked me why I drive an hour to church instead of watching the live stream. I come because of the community and connection I feel when I am interacting with others who are also part of God's chosen people. I come because I can experience and provide compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience as I participate in the activities that keep our church alive. We can always count on God's love but need never forget the many ways we can mindfully return that love to others as we go about our daily lives.
